Breeding An Efficient Herd

With a background in farming from Hopetoun, Victoria, and a PhD in genetics, he helps livestock producers improve profitability through genetic selection and improved management. He hosts the Head Shepherd podcast and co-founded Genesmith, which develops AI and machine vision technology for livestock farming. Based in Christchurch, he works with farmers and industry organisations throughout both countries.

A lot is expected of the humble beef cow and with new traits coming on stream all the time, achieving the right balance can seem increasingly difficult. This talk will explore the combination of traits that is likely to result in an efficient herd on a per hectare basis rather than per head. It will examine the concept of whole body energy, efficiency of weight gain, efficiency of weight loss, interactions with nutritional status and what it all means for breeding cow reproduction. The talk will delve into how traits like body condition score, hip height and mature cow weight fit into future breeding programs.

You Don't Need Wings To Fly

While jackarooing in the Northern Territory Sam Bailey became a C6/C7 quadriplegic in a car accident. Despite severe physical limitations he went home to the family property and became a farmer. In 1999 he proposed to his wife Jenny – a radio journalist - 'live' on ABC Radio and they went on to run a beef cattle property at Croppa Creek in North West NSW for quarter of a century. Sam appeared on 'Australian Story', his book "Head Over Heels" is a best seller, and he's working towards becoming the first quadriplegic in the world to fly a helicopter.

Dan Shike, Professor in Beef Cow/Calf Nutrition and Management and Interim Head in the Department of Animal Science at the University of Illinois.

What is the ideal cow?

Professor Dan Shike earned his A.S. from Black Hawk College – East Campus and B.S. in Animal Sciences and Industry at Kansas State University. He received his M.S. and Ph.D. at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Dan's research focuses on identifying nutritional strategies and management practices that improve efficiency, reproduction and profitability in beef cow/calf production. Dan has authored over 80 peer-reviewed publications and given over 75 invited presentations.

This session will focus on how the type of beef cattle have evolved through selection and planned matings targeted at meeting consumer demands and maximising producer profitability. Over the past hundred years, cattle have increased in frame size and lean growth in the US, with more focus in the late 80's using performance records, sire evaluations, and expected progeny differences (EPD) being utilised in conjunction with visual appraisal for selection and breeding decisions. In the 2000's and 2010's breed associations introduced bioeconomic indexes allowing multiple traits to be combined into a single value.

The information and tools available to cattle breeders has dramatically increased and so has the complexity of breeding programs. Ideal beef cattle type has evolved as selection decisions continue to focus on meeting consumer demands and maximising producer profitability.

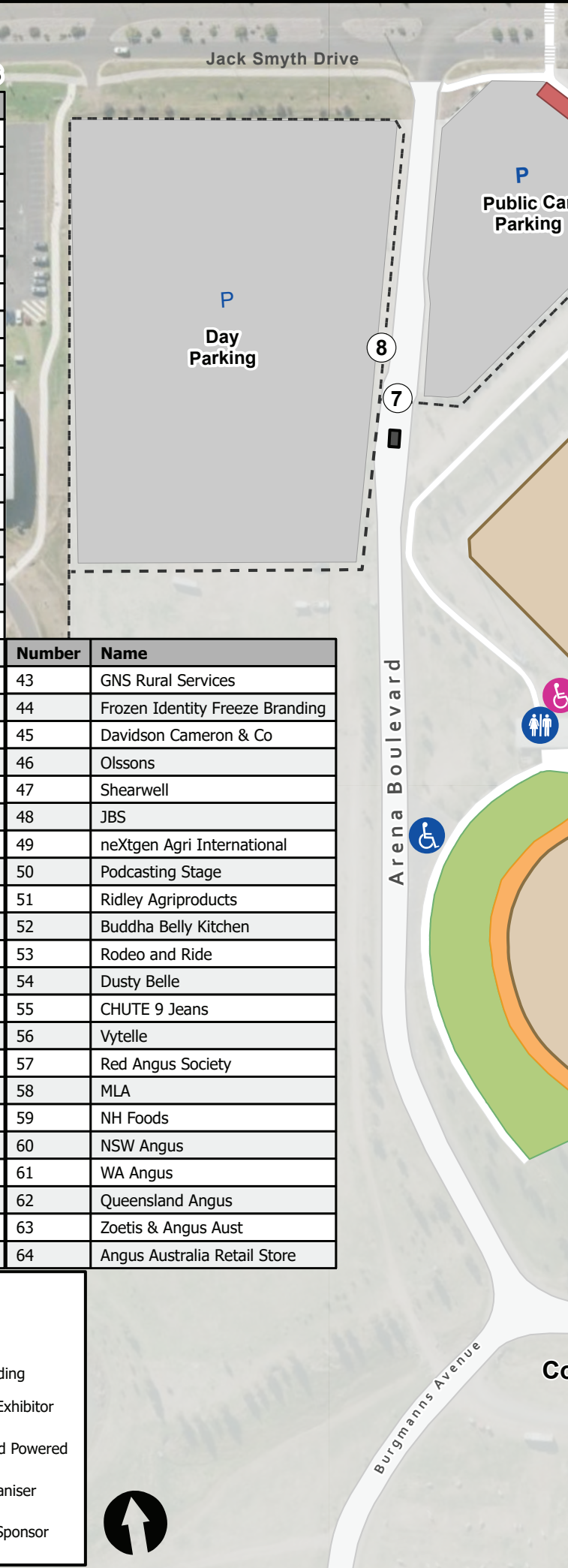
